### 3. BIO PROFILE

---

Professor Dimitrios J. Dimitriou is a senior academic and management scientist whose career integrates higher education, international research activity and executive leadership in complex organisations and large capital intensive projects. His academic background combines management, engineering and quantitative economics, including a Doctorate in econometric modelling for demand forecasting, postgraduate studies in Planning and Management and Environmental Management, and a Civil Engineering diploma specialised in project planning and asset management.

With more than three decades of professional activity, his experience is structured across three complementary domains: academic teaching and supervision, scientific research and innovation, and governance of organisations and large projects/investments. This combination allows him to operate simultaneously as scholar, institutional strategist and practitioner, bridging theoretical knowledge with operational implementation in public and private sector environments. His extent and international experience provides rare alignment between academic leadership and real-world organisational management, particularly relevant to leading a Department of Management where administration, budgeting, accreditation and stakeholder relations are central functions.

Educationally, Professor Dimitriou has long-standing teaching experience at undergraduate and postgraduate level in national and international universities, delivering courses in decision theory, strategic management, risk management, organizational behaviour, business ethics, investment appraisal, transport economics and decision support systems. He contributes to multiple MBA and MSc programs across interdisciplinary areas including corporate management, administration, supply chain management, occupational health and safety and health systems management. His teaching philosophy is oriented toward, integration of analytics with managerial judgement, linking theory with real organisational cases, interdisciplinary education connecting engineering, economics and management, preparation of graduates for complex decision environments.

It is noteworthy that Prof. Dimitriou maintain research teams, academics, professionals and lead innovated research. His research activity is extensive and internationally recognised. The scale and diversity of his publications demonstrate continuous research productivity and international academic presence. His work combines quantitative modelling with managerial decision frameworks, contributing to applied policy and industry practice. His scientific output includes a very large body of peer-reviewed publications, books, book chapters and conference papers, covering areas such as strategic management and corporate performance, sustainability and ESG evaluation, infrastructure economics and investment appraisal, business analytics and decision modelling, organisational resilience and risk governance, supply chain and project management etc. His publication

record includes more than 400 papers, presentations and lectures in globally distinguished international events; peer review referred journals; scientific books; international peer review conferences; international and national congress and workshops; and scientific seminars, events and professional institution events. He was co-organiser in more than 20 scientific events and conferences while he is the scientific organizer of International Conference "Intermodal Transports: Innovations in Planning, Management, Business Development & Decision Making", (<https://vip4ride.com>).

Parallel to his academic career, Professor Dimitriou has served in senior executive and advisory roles in major public organisations and enterprises, including board-level and chairmanship positions in transport authorities and international infrastructure companies. He was Chairman of the Board of Directors (2016-2020) at Athens International Airport and member of the Board of Directors since 2015, contributing in one of the most profitable companies and processing one of the larger privatisations in Greece. He was Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer in Athens Transports Organisation (3 years/2010-2012). He has extended experience in executive advisory and senior consulting positions, highlighting: Advisor in ADA in Kingdom of Saudi Arabia; Management of Evros Bank; executive advisor in Athens Metro operation company; advisory team in national organisations such as Ministry of Infrastructures, Transports, Prefecture association etc. In 2020-21 he was Vice Chairman of Eydimos SA, a company deals with the project planning and management for large projects in four municipalities in Attika Region. From 2022 to 2025, he was Board Member in MOVYON SEE, a daughter company of MOVYON Spa/Italy which focused on ITS in motorways that belongs to Autostrate per Italia Motorways SA which consist of a leader motorways operator in Europe.

He maintains an extensive international academic and professional network through participation in international expert committees, research collaborations and presentations to international organisations and professional bodies. His collaborations include universities, international agencies and industry partners across Europe, North America and beyond, enabling joint research projects, student mobility and internships, curriculum internationalisation, external funding opportunities.

His professional contribution has been recognised through national and international awards for scientific activity, professional achievement and contribution to regional industry development.
