1. Introduction This Privacy Policy of the Department of Economics at Democritus University of Thrace explains how we collect, use, and protect your personal data in accordance with the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and applicable legislation.

2. Collection of Personal Data We collect personal data through the following means:

- When you fill out forms on our website
- When you register for the Department's services
- When you contact the Department's Secretariat
- Through cookies and similar technologies

The personal data we collect may include, among other things, your name, email address, phone number, IP address, and information required for academic purposes.

3. Use of Personal Data Your personal data is used for the following purposes:

- Managing academic records and services
- Communication for informational and administrative purposes
- Compliance with legal obligations
- Analysis and improvement of student and faculty experience

4. Data Sharing We do not sell, rent, or exchange your personal data. We may share it with:

- Other services of Democritus University of Thrace for academic purposes
- Competent authorities when required by law

5. Data Security We take appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data from unauthorized access, loss, or malicious use.

6. User Rights Under GDPR, you have the following rights:

- Access your data
- Rectify or erase your data
- Restrict or object to data processing
- Data portability
- Withdraw consent for data processing
